# Dubai International Academy (DIA) Al Barsha\*

Al Barsha Road, Al Barsha 1, Dubai UAE

DIA Al Barsha is conveniently situated close to Mall of the Emirates, roughly 30 minutes by car from Dubai International Airport and 40 minutes from Dubai World Central.

\* Note that there are two DIA schools in Dubai – please ensure that you are visiting DIA Al Barsha not DIA Emirates Hills.



# **HOW TO GET THERE**

Dubai has two world-class airports\* – Dubai International Airport (DXB) and Dubai World Central (DWC). Both offer transport options for getting into the city.

Once you are in Dubai, there are plenty of <u>public or private transport options</u>, including <u>Dubai Metro</u> and taxis are plentiful and cheap and can be hailed from the side of the road. They can be paid for with cash (UAE Dirhams) or a credit/debit card. Be aware that you might be offered a black limo from the airport (sometimes the taxi rank officials try to direct you to these especially if it is busy), but these are more expensive than the normal cream-coloured taxis. Single female travellers might want to look out for "pink" taxis which are driven by female drivers.

While in Dubai, you can book taxis via the **Careem** app on your smartphone and will be offered either a Careem car or a standard taxi. If you need to telephone for a taxi at any point, the number to use is 800 88088. Alternatively, you can use **Uber** in Dubai.

Dubai International Academy Al Barsha is on a number of bus routes and is just a 15-minute walk from the metro station at the Mall of the Emirates.

If you are resident in Dubai and wish to drive to DIA Al Barsha, there is plenty of parking at the front of the school.

\* Before you travel to the UAE, please <u>check visa requirements</u> and make sure you have a valid visa if needed. Please ensure that your passport has at least 6 months validity.

### WHERE TO STAY

There is a wide range of hotels in the Al Barsha area, with plenty of options to suit a range of budgets including brands such as IBIS, Sheraton, CityMax, Millennium and Novotel Suites.

We recommend using either the hotel's own website or using one of the very popular booking sites like <a href="hotels.com">hotels.com</a> or <a href="booking.com">booking.com</a>, and searching for hotels to suit your budget in the Dubai Al Barsha area.

Please note that we do not recommend that you make any non-refundable travel or accommodation arrangements until you have received confirmation in writing that your workshop will go ahead. We reserve the right to cancel any workshops which do not gain sufficient bookings to make them viable to run.

### WHAT TO BRING

### TEN THINGS TO DO IN DUBAI

- 1. Go up the Burj Khalifa (book in advance online) or just go and watch the fountains at the foot of it at Dubai Mall https://www.burjkhalifa.ae
- 2. Wander around Al Fahidi Historical Neighbourhood in Bur Dubai, with its winding alleyways and wind towers. Get a taste of Old Dubai during the mid-19th century.
- Visit Dubai Creek and take in the Gold Souq and Spice Souq, cross the creek on an Abra (small boat) or walk along Al Seef area <a href="https://alseef.ae/en">https://alseef.ae/en</a>
- 4. Visit a museum, Dubai Museum, Etihad Museum or Museum of the Future (this one has to be booked a month or so in advance online) <a href="https://museumofthefuture.ae">https://museumofthefuture.ae</a>
- 5. Go skiing at Mall of the Emirates, indoor ski slope or just enjoy the snow <a href="https://www.skidxb.com">https://www.skidxb.com</a>
- 6. Explore Madinat Jumeriah with its modern souq and plenty of restaurants, there is also The theatre of the Digital Age to visit <a href="https://www.toda.ae/en/">https://www.toda.ae/en/</a>
- 7. Take a walk along the beach alongside Jumeriah Beach Road or use a scooter or bike
- 8. Take in a show at Dubai Opera <a href="https://www.dubaiopera.com">https://www.dubaiopera.com</a>
- 9. Travel to the Palm and go to The Pointe or visit Nakheel Mall or The Atlantis
- 10. Go on a desert safari, city tour or dhow cruise or take a trip to Abu Dhabi to see the amazing Sheikh Zayed Grand Mosque

#### **VISIT TO THE OBSERVATORIES**

Pick up 17:00 from DIA Al Barsha Drop off approx 22:00 to your hotel or nearest metro Price AED 395 (USD 110) per person

This tour starts with a visit to **The View at The Palm** located in the biggest manmade island in the world (Palm Jumeirah). Placed on The Palm Tower's 52nd floor (240 meters), The View at The Palm gives you the chance to take in the Palm Jumeirah, along with its 16 fronds, the trunk, and the crescent, in its entire splendor.

Next drive along Sheikh Zayed Road to view some of Dubai's most recognizable architectural landmarks. At Zabeel Park you will visit Dubai's latest attraction — Dubai Frame. Soaring 150m high and connected by a 100m bridge with a partial glass floor, Dubai Frame offers stunning 360° views of Dubai's Old Quarter to one side and its futuristic skyline to the other.

The tour continues towards the downtown Burj Dubai district to visit Burj Khalifa, the tallest building in the world. Enter the complex and board a high-speed lift which ascends to the observation deck at 10 meters per second. As the doors open on level 124, floor-to-ceiling glass walls provide breath-taking 360-degree views of the city, desert and ocean sprawled beneath. On your return, there is time to see the **Dubai Aquarium** and **Dubai Fountain** which are located in the Dubai Mall.

- Swear in public or made rude gestures you can get yourself into big trouble
- Take somebody's picture without their consent, it is considered as an invasion of privacy of that person.
   It is also illegal to take photos of strategic and military locations, government organisations or political buildings for security reasons
- Eat, drink or chew gum on public transport
- Consume alcohol in public places or drink and drive
- Indulge in Public Displays of Affection

### **FAQs**

#### What is included in the workshop fee?

Tuition from workshop leaders, all workshop materials, lunches and refreshments (see below) and admin support during the event.

#### How do I get from the airport to my hotel?

By far the easiest way is to take one of the many and reasonably priced taxis which are right outside the airport terminal. These are safe at any time of the day and single lady travellers are often offered a female driver (pink taxi).







#### How do I get from my hotel to the workshop venue?

Please take either a local bus, taxi or walk to the venue if you prefer. If you are driving, please come to the main entrance of DIA Al Barsha on Al Barsha Road.


#### When do the workshops start?

Please come through the main school entrance of Dubai International Academy (DIA) Al Barsha between 08:30 and 09:00 on Day 1 of your workshop to register and collect your name badge.

There is no need to register at the front desks on subsequent days.

#### What should I wear?

#### Do I need an electrical adaptor?

The electricity current is 220/240volts and requires 3-pin plugs (UK plugs work without an adaptor).

#### Can I access the internet at the school?

Wi-Fi is available in most areas of the school for your own smart phone/laptop. School ICT facilities are also available during break times.

#### What meals are provided?

Lunches and refreshments – including vegetarian options - are provided on Day 1 and Day 2 during the workshop. On Day 3 we finish before lunch but will provide refreshments at the morning break. ### Is alcohol available in Dubai?

Dubai's licensing laws require venues serving alcohol be attached to hotels or a private clubs. It is illegal to drink in the street or in a public space.

#### What is the currency in Dubai?

The currency in the UAE is the Arab Emirates Dirham (AED).

#### What is the time difference?

The UAE is 4 hours ahead of GMT.

#### Do I get a Certificate after the event?

Yes, this will be sent to you as a PDF document around 2 weeks after the event.

#### How do I evaluate the workshop?

You will be emailed a link to complete an online evaluation form.

#### Where are the best places to shop?

Shopping is a pastime in Dubai whether in souks or malls. Mall of the Emirates (close to the workshop hotel and venue) and Dubai Mall (downtown but next to the world-famous Burj Khalifa) are extremely popular and are very busy in the evenings and at weekends.
